Day 1

- Types of threat actors, with case studies 1h
 - o Single individuals/“Lone Wolf”
 - o Accidents or incidents that are not directly terrorism
 - o Terrorist groups
 - o Hoaxes and Diversion
- Philosophy of CBRN Protection in the VIP Security Mission – Basic principles 1h
- How to organize close protection around the CBRN Threat – Several different models 1.30h
 - o Basic overview of different methods of CBRN Close protection
- Selecting appropriate equipment for your mission 1h

Day 2

Integrating CBRN Skills into the VIP Protection Mission (Classroom Lectures)

- CBRN VIP Protection can be turned into 6 “Threat Profiles” and 1 general procedure for everything else 1h
- Battle Drill 1 – Nerve Agent 1h
- Battle Drill 2 – Blood Agent 1h
- Battle Drill 3 – General Respiratory Distress 1h
- Battle Drill 4 – Unknown Powder or liquid on the Protectee 1h
- Battle Drill 5 – Protectee is stuck with a needle or other sharp object 1h
- Battle Drill 6 – General Irritation of Skin and Eyes 1h
- The default Plan for Everything Else 1h
 - o Developing a general “Operational Mindset” that covers the non-acute scenarios not covered by the 6 battle drills

Day 3

Planning and Operations (Classroom Lectures)

- Antiterrorism Search Operations – CBRN considerations 0.45h
- Integrating Detection/Identification in Close Protection Operations 1h

- Moving – Situations and events that happen while in a motorcade (1 Scenario) 1h
- Dealing with Catastrophic Events (2 Scenarios) 2h
- Orientation and Preparation for the Practical Exercises in the Following Day 1h
